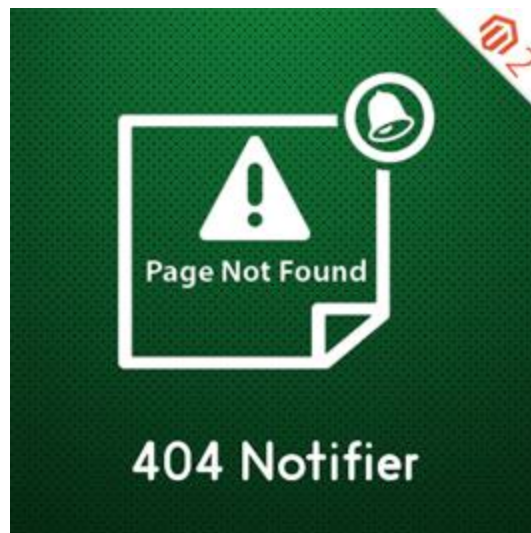


# 404 Notifier extension User Manual



Magento 2 404 Notifier helps you get Email notification for every 404 page attempt by users.


## 1. Extension Installation Guide

- Go to My downloadable products. The file that you download normally is a zip file.
- Use FTP client (such as Filezilla, WinSCP, cuteFtp) to upload or copy all folders in the zip package to your Magento site root folder. This will not overwrite any existing files, just add new files to the folder structure.
- Open Command line in folder root of Magento and run following command respectively:
  - php bin/magento setup:upgrade
  - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
  - php bin/magento indexer:reindex
  - php bin/magento cache:flush
- Navigate to Stores/Configuration, if you can see the extension tab, it is installed properly.

## 2. Configuration

Once you have successfully installed the extension, go to **Stores → Configuration** to configure the extension for use. Here you can find various settings for the extension.

- **404 Notifier:** Enable or disable 404 Notifier extension from here.
- **Send Emails To:** Enter Email ID of the admin on which you want to receive mails for 404 page notifications.
- **Email Sender:** Select Email sender from the drop down.
- **Email Template:** Select template for 404 notification Email.

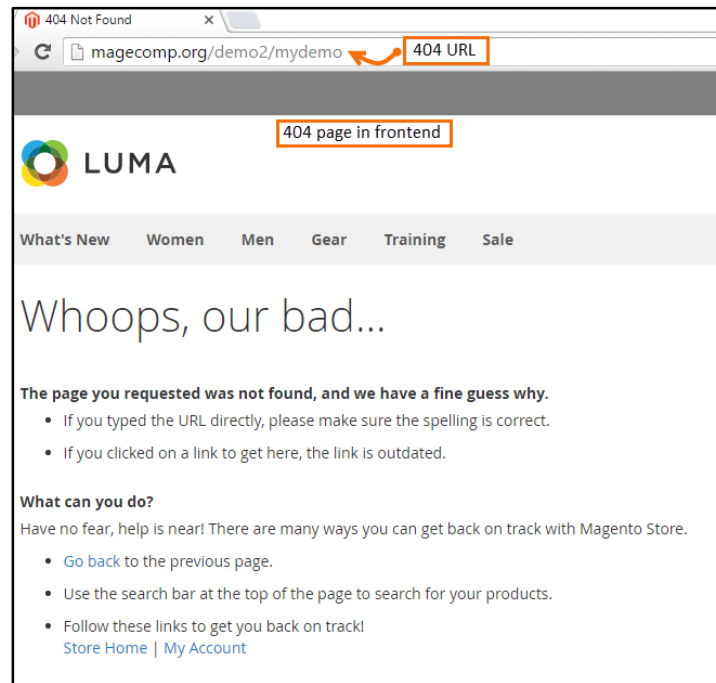

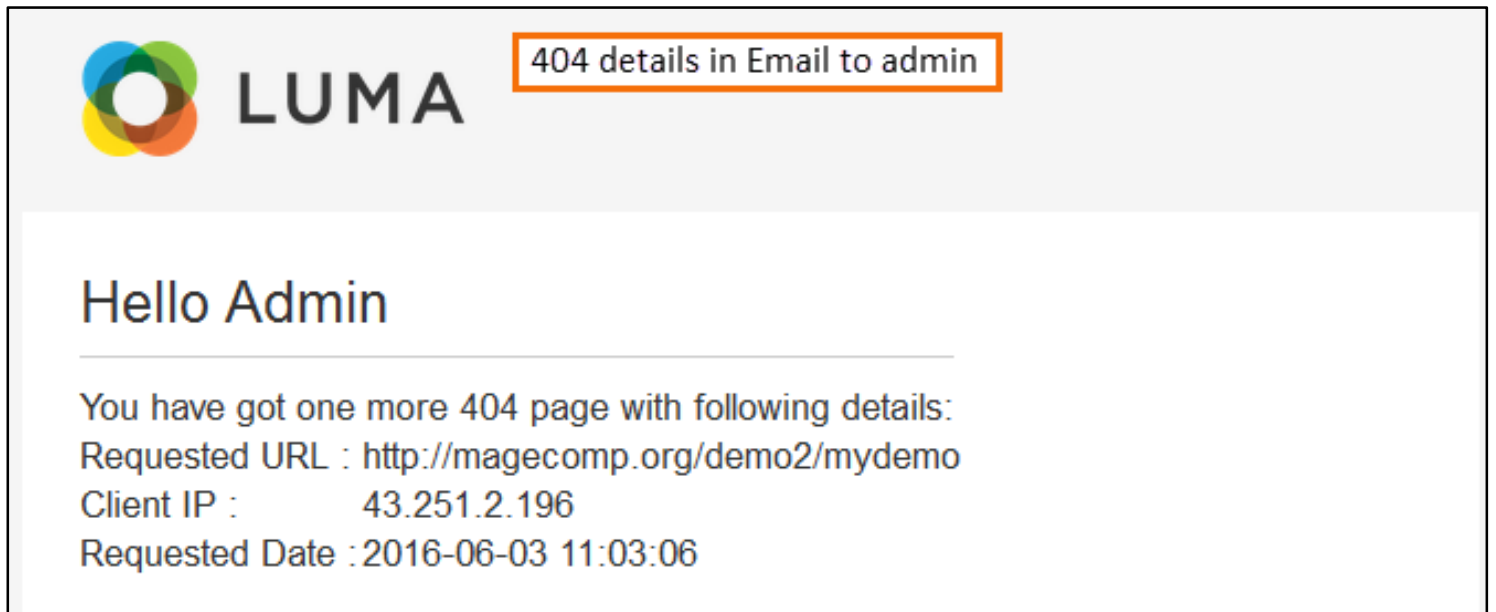

### 3. 404 Notifier in Frontend

Once you have successfully configured 404 Notifier. Try typing wrong URL or get 404 URL on your website.



- Once any 404 page is typed or searched, immediately admin get notification on registered Email ID.



#### 4. 404 Notifications in backend

Apart from Email notification to admin, every 404 attempts get recorded in backend in a separate grid as well. Go to MageComp 404 Notifier → 404 Notifications, here you can find a separate grid of 404 notifications along with the details like URL, client IP and date and time of 404 attempt.

#### 5. Deactivation of Extension in Case of Emergency

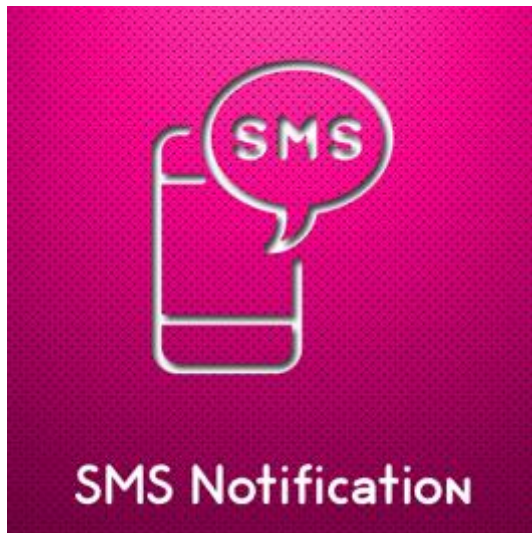
- Go to **app** → **etc** → **config.php** and find '**Magecomp\_Pagenotfound**' => **1**, and replace 1 with 0.

- **What if I get “Access denied” error after installation of the extension?**  
Whenever you get Access denied error while clicking on the extension tab after installation, log out admin panel and re-login.
